NOTICE OF BOARD ELECTIONS
Four Seats Available

At this year's Annual General Meeting there will be three (3) elected positions each for a term of two (2) years and representing specific sector interests, namely:

- one (1) representative from the **Accommodator** sector, who shall be a voting member of the Board. Accommodators are defined as an accommodation facility in the Nelson & Kootenay Lake area that collects the MRDT (Municipal, Regional and District Tax).
- one (1) representative from the **Spring-Summer-Fall/Outdoor/Adventure Activity** sector, who shall be a voting member of the Board. This representative is defined as a tourism-related business operating in the months of April to November in the NKLT region.
- one (1) representative that is the **Director at Large**, who shall be a voting member of the Board. This representative is defined as a tourism-related business operating in the NKLT region.

This year there is one (1) Appointed representative. The recipient will be announced at the AGM:

- one (1) representative from the **Balfour & District Business and Heritage Association | RDCK E & F**, representing all area tourism stakeholders, who shall be a voting member of the Board.
